- Transportation Efficiency
 - Transporting students to SMS is approximately one mile closer.
 - Four-lane US 1 provides a quicker bus route than the constrained and congested roads to PBMS: IGP and Pacetti Road
 - Will allow bus pickup to be approximately 10 minutes later on the 8 buses serving Palencia/Kensington/Las Calinas at a cost savings of \$8000.
 - Reduce the need to add another ESE bus at the cost of \$145,000

- Future Transportation Challenges and Traffic Congestion
 - Straightening of the curve on IGP
 - Construction of CR 2209 from SilverLeaf to SR 16

- K-8 Structure and Capacity
 - Would need to evaluate the impact of adding an elementary school to a K-8 school
 - No K-8s with current capacity in the area
 - New K-8 School RR will open 2026-2027
